Incident/Charge: Theft; Investigation & Arrest

On 03/07/2009 Joseph Mangino of Little Ferry, NJ was arrested by Det. Inserra. Mr. Mangino was charged with theft of a radio from the Moonachie Civic Center. The alleged theft took place on 02/06/2009 during a Cub Scout event at the civic center. During the Pinewood Derby contest the radio, assorted cd's, soda, and a few t-shirts were reported missing from a storage closet. Det. Inserra was given the name of a suspect and checked the Cash Converters store in Saddle Brook, NJ. The suspect was in the store on 02/07/09 selling items including a radio fitting the description of the one stolen. There was also an outstanding warrant for Mangino from the Palisades Park Municipal Court for \$930.00.

Incident/Charge: Theft; Investigation & Arrest

On 03/13/2009 Joseph Massa of Wood-Ridge, NJ was charged with theft by Det. Fugnitti. The theft took place around February 15, 2009. The theft involved a package that was supposed to be delivered to 234 Moonachie Road in Moonachie. The package was valued at \$2,250.00. The accused is a driver for Federal Express, and the package was never delivered to 234 Moonachie Road, according to Det. Fugnitti. Mr. Massa turned himself in to police at police headquarters accompanied by his attorney. Det. Inserra processed the accused and he was released on bail.
